II. Sources of Energy Data

Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry (ASPBI) and Census of Philippine Business and Industry (CPBI)

is the establishment based surveys/census where data on energy statistics is being generated

III. Uses of Establishment Based Data

- **data from establishment-based surveys are used in:**
 - ✓ **System of National Accounts (SNA)**
 - ✓ **Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 9)**
 - ✓ **generating MSME (micro, small and medium establishments/enterprises) data using total employment**
 - ✓ **gathers information to updating the characteristics of the list of establishments**

III. Uses of Establishment Based Data

- data from establishment-based surveys are used in:
 - ✓ **Generating indicators** for industries such as
 - Value added
 - Labor productivity
 - Average compensation
 - ✓ **evaluating the performance of industries for national and regional development planning and monitoring**
 - ✓ **data enclave for researchers**

III. Methods of Data Gathering in ASPBI

The following activities are being adopted by ASPBI and CPBI:

- uses concepts and methodologies patterned after **United Nation System of National Accounts and Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD)**

III. Methods of Data Gathering in ASPBI

- **uses classification standards**
 - ✓ **Philippine Standards Industrial Classification**
which is aligned with ISIC Rev 4
 - ✓ **Philippine Standard Geographic Classification**
as of 31 December 2016



III. Methods of Data Gathering in ASPBI

✓ Utilization of

- **Sampling Methodology**
- **Questionnaire Design**
- **Data Processing, Review and Tabulation**



III. Methods of Data Gathering in ASPBI

➤ Utilization of Sampling Methodology

- **CPBI and ASPBI uses stratified systematic sampling design with 5-digit PSIC serving as industry strata and total employment as the second stratification variable**

III. Methods of Data Gathering in ASPBI

- Utilizes Questionnaire Designs in all surveys

Parallel with the **Philippine accounting principles** and **Systems of National Accounts**

7 types of self-administered and web – based sectoral questionnaires
one of the questionnaires is used for collection of data for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply

III. Statistics and Indicators Generated

- **ASPBI aims to collect and generate detailed information on employment, income, expense, capital expenditures and total assets of the establishments**
- **ASPBI generates indicators such as value added, labor productivity, average compensation and others necessary to evaluate the performance of industries at the national and regional levels**

III. Statistics and Indicators Generated

- **ASPBI generates indicators such as:**
- ✓ **value added**
- ✓ **labor productivity**
- ✓ **average compensation**

to evaluate the performance of industries at the national and regional levels

III. Statistics and Indicators Generated

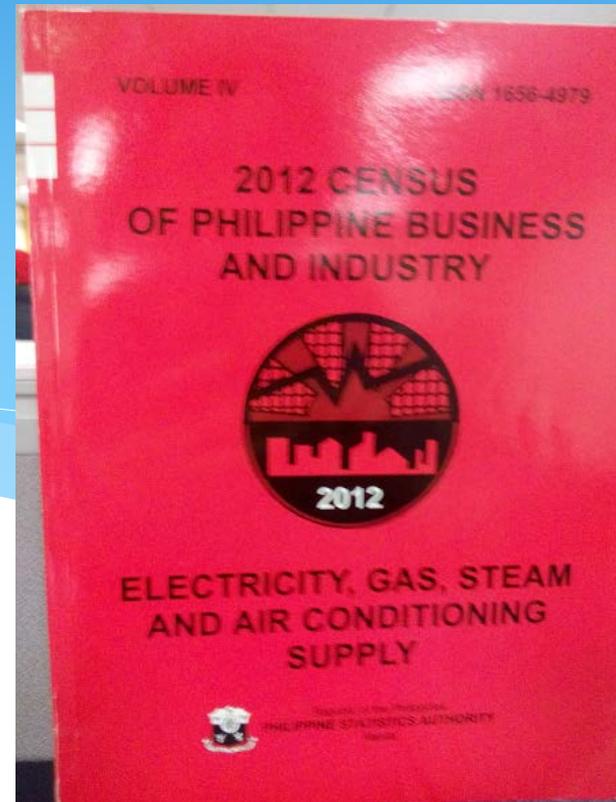
- **ASPBI generates data on electricity, gas steam and airconditioning supply.**
- **Data are generated at the 5-digit PSIC as follows:**
 - D35100 - Electric power generation, transmission and distribution**

Note: Data on renewable energy is not available in ASPBI and CPBI
