SDGs are integrated into various national development plans/framework which is integrated to national monitoring




Built on existing platform and processes




Linkages between national and other reporting

Challenges

- Scope (>230 indicators)
- Data disaggregation and coverage of all population groups
- Quality, timeliness, reliability and accessibility

Opportunities

- New data sources
- Partnerships with new data communities
- Strengthening the role of NSOs
- Strengthening basic data production
